## SHORT PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Culture is a comprehensive concept, which can be interpreted in many different ways and with different definitions. Culture can be understood in a narrower sense as an activity that encompasses the sphere of the human mind, especially artistic, activity and creativity. Cultures, however, differ mainly between countries, and even between regions. Slovenia has a wide variety of cultures, which differ mainly according to region. Today, with globalization, the cultures of individual countries and regions are disappearing, and globalization has resulted in the unification of cultures. This can be seen in dress styles, food, music, and architecture. This problem and the forgetting of 'home culture' is particularly noticeable among young people, who are the 'victims' of globalization and cultural homogenization. Many young people do not even know their region's and country's cultural history, as customs and habits have already changed over the years. This problem is not only a problem for young people in Slovenia but also in other European countries, where young people are forgetting the culture of their home country due to globalization. Young people also do not see culture as an entrepreneurial opportunity to develop their own entrepreneurial path with the history of culture.
